Public Works Reports

CAO, on behalf of Public Works, verbally reported the following information to Council:

- Failing curb-stop valve was repaired (not replaced) in order to turn water off residential service due to unpaid utility bill. This repair saved \$250.00 as a new valve wasn't required.
- Residential curb-stop on Road Allowance was lowered in order to protect it from damage.
- > Only 5 golden willow saplings had to replace from the 230 originally planted this summer.
- > Chlorine injection pump failed as the injector broke. New (standby) unit installed.
- > Water turbidity testing equipment shipped to Clear-Tech for recalibration.

- > Getting quotes to repair the pressure washer/steamer in preparation for spring thawing of frozen culverts.
- > The hall is short 27 chairs out of the usual 200, searching for the missing ones. Also noted that the in-house microphone couldn't be located. Jeffrey advised he will provide his personal microphone for the upcoming wedding until the missing microphone is located.
- > Received lagoon enzyme to help with breaking down of solids in the lagoon.
- > Grass was cut around lagoon and protective covers for the lagoon valves were installed.
- ➤ Lowest recorded turbidity level was measured at 0.11, noting that 1.0 is the maximum acceptable upper level by SK Water regulations. This much clearer water is believed to be largely due to the new stainless-steel pipes in the water treatment plant.
- > Grass mowing throughout the village is slowing down as the growing season slows.
- Dust control performed on 100 & 200 block Main Street.
- ➤ Lift-Station backup generator failed to kick-in during a short power outage. There was 2 feet over water over the floor in the morning of August 19th. The electrical panel/breaker was reset and all is operating properly. This will be monitored.
- Solution Gas monitor was recalibrated in Yorkton and half of the required planter blocks were picked up at McMunn & Yates while in Yorkton.
- ➤ The Sysco transport truck was taking the wrong route when delivering to the clinic. The driver was provided with the proper route to avoid catching a telephone cable on Anderson Avenue. This will be monitored every Wednesday.
- A used glass display cabinet was picked up from a local resident to be used in the museum.
- ➤ 40 cubic yards (2 loads) of sand for the arena ice surface will soon be delivered.
- > The on-demand water heater for the recreation centre was replaced today (August 21st)
